Note: to become a member of the Golf Club, you must be a member of the Ngunguru Sports and Recreation Society (excluding Juniors). Current Membership is \$60 per year, application forms are available at the bar or in the office.

Use of Motorised Golf Vehicle's on the Golf Course is permitted at owner's risk, however will be subject to course and weather conditions. Please check prior to use. NB. A Medical certificate will be required for certain competitions.

Etiquette

In the interest of all, players should play without delay.

No player should play until the players in front are out of range.

Players searching for a ball should signal the players following to pass when it is apparent the ball will not be easy to find.

Play should cease until players called through are out of range.

Leave the putting green immediately the hole has been completed.

The lowest handicap player in each four should take responsibility for course etiquette.

The status of a golf club may be judged by the etiquette of its members.

Conditions of Play

Eligibility to Enter

Only financial full playing members with an official handicap can participate in Trophy and Club competitions. No handicap capping will apply for internal Club competitions except for the Ferguson Trophy. 9 hole players are eligible to play in the four mixed trophy Competitions-Stainton Trophy, Soich Plate, Finlayson Trophy, Matapouri Trophy.

Match Play

Each round must be completed on or before the date specified. Matches finishing all square must continue hole by hole until decided. Strokes are taken at the same holes as in the first 18 holes (refer NZGA Golf Club Manual).

In any matter under dispute, the decision of the committee shall be final.

Behaviour during play

No one should move, talk, and stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke. The Player who has the honour should, in the interest of fast play, move directly to the teeing ground and play his or her shot before marking their card.

Pace of Play

Your position on the course should be behind the group in front of you, not in front of the group behind you. Ready golf is encouraged when safe to do so.

Handicaps

Check your handicap before each round of play. A score card must be submitted for handicapping purposes except for match play and "off the stick" competitions. When returning a score card it must be signed by competitor and marker.

World Handicap System 2020

NZ golf has adopted the world handicap system. Handicaps are now calculated taking the best 8 out of the last 20 scores submitted.

In a Stableford competition if you get 36 points you have played to your handicap. In mixed Stableford events there is no adjustment in handicap for the ladies and men. However in a Nett event at Ngunguru when ladies and men play together as "Fellow Competitors", ladies are awarded 3 extra handicap strokes per 18 hole round to reflect the difference in Pars (65 - 62)
